VI. ACTION ITEMS

a. Old Business

Ms. Patel opened the floor to discuss the Sweat-Free Campus Project and Mr. Chiairiamonte, Director of Retail Services for Spartan Shops, addressed their position. He noted the Athletics Department controls the licensing of SJSU products then explained the relationship between colleges and sweatshop labor. Mr. Geiger explained why SAGE is encouraging an affiliation between SJSU and the WRC. Mr. Chiairiamonte explained the affiliation of SJSU with FLA and possibly with the WRC, as well as steps SJSU is currently taking to fight sweatshop labor. Mr. Bridgeman explained why the exclusive nature of WRC is beneficial and what SAGE is seeking. Mr. Geiger explained recent action taken toward WRC affiliation.

Ms. Patel initiated discussing the plan for an Advising Success Packet. Mr. Drescher distributed copies of his plan for the academic success packet, explained his plan, and described how it would affect SJSU students. Discussion took place about improvement of the maps. Mr. Sakadjian suggested A.S. provide departments with an electronic copy of these maps to facilitate departmental updating and printing for students. Mr. Ford suggested surveying SJSU students to obtain their opinions about this issue.
